ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16 ENTITLED  
"AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR  
SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICE AND PROVIDING PROCEDURES  
FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT"

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County

Water District, San Benito County, California, as follows:

Section 1. Article VIII of Ordinance No. 16, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Rates and Charges for Sewage Disposal Service and Providing Procedures for Its Enforcement", passed and adopted August 10, 1972, as amended by Ordinance No. 35, is hereby amended by amending Section 70 thereof, to read as follows:

"70. Rate Schedule. Sewer service charges are hereby established as follows:

	<u>Service Charges</u>	<u>Charge Per month</u>
1. Single family dwelling		\$ 16.00
2. Multiple family dwellings, duplexes, flats and apartments		16.00/unit
3. Auto courts, motels, trailer parks		8.00/unit
4. Office buildings, hotels, rooming house: First unit		16.00
Each additional unit		6.40
5. Commercial houses, schools, churches: First fixture		16.00
Each additional toilet, urinal, shower, laundrette unit, restaurant, sink, dishwasher, wash rack, etc.		6.40
6. Industrial, business, laundries, laundrettes, restaurants, bars, theaters, service stations, garages, chemical plants		16.00 minimum plus .50 per 100 cu. ft. of water used in excess of 1000 cu. ft.

The District shall have the option of charging all large users on the basis of volume of sewage discharged into the sewer system.

The metered discharge from those pumps having a final discharge into the sewer system shall be charged on the same basis as metered water furnished by the District.

For any business or occupancy not listed, the charge shall be in such amount as may be established by District, by motion, resolution or ordinance.

District shall have the option of providing sewer service outside the boundaries of District on the basis of charges to be established by special sewer service agreement."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be posted in three public places within the District.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect March 1, 1990.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
