

ORDINANCE NO. 42

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS, THE INSTALLATION OF SEWER LATERALS AND PUBLIC SEWER MAIN EXTENSIONS PROVIDING FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF A SANITARY INSPECTOR, PROVIDING PERMITS AND FIXING FEES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SANITARY SEWER LATERALS AND REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM OF THE SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, as follows:

Section 1. Article IX, Section 9.12 of Ordinance No. 15, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 9.12. Fees and Bond-Public Sewer Construction. A fee to pay all engineering, administrative, inspection, legal and other costs required to ensure compliance with the terms of the permit and with rules, regulations and ordinances of the District shall be paid to the District prior to the time the permit is issued for reviewing plans and specifications, issuing a permit and inspecting the installation of public sewer mains, laterals and all appurtenances thereto. The fees shall be based upon the estimated costs of the construction of the sewer mains, laterals and appurtenances and shall be established at least annually by Resolution of the Board of Directors.

The fees established pursuant to this Section shall be paid in advance of the District incurring engineering, inspection, administrative, legal or other costs. In the event fees are not so paid in advance the District shall not perform any services until such fees are paid.

Fees established pursuant to the authority granted in this Section shall be reviewed at least annually. Any modification of the fee schedule shall be accomplished by Resolution of the District Board of Directors.

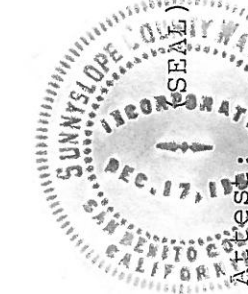
Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section of phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the 30th day after its passage and shall be published once in the Evening Free Lance, a newspaper of general publication circulation published and printed in the County of San Benito, State of California, together with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against same prior to fifteen (15) days from its passage hereof.

RESOLUTION OF THE SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER
DISTRICT ESTABLISHING INSPECTION FEES PURSUANT
TO ORDINANCE NO. 42

WHEREAS, ORDINANCE No. 42 provides that the Sunnyslope County Water District shall initially establish administrative, inspection, engineering and legal fees and at least annually thereafter, review the fee structure and

and is prepared to establish initial inspection fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District resolve as follows:

1. Fee schedule: The following fees shall be charged by the District for inspection, administrative, engineering and legal costs relating to public sewer mains, laterals and appurtenances for subdivisions and/or new developments, which fees are based upon the estimated costs of construction of the sewer mains, laterals and appurtenances:

Estimated Cost of Construction	Fee
First \$50,000	5%
\$50,000 to \$150,000	4%
Over \$150,000	3%

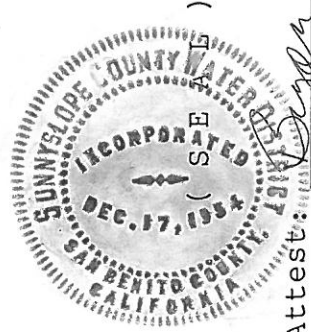
2. Review of fee schedule: The fee schedule established in this Resolution shall be reviewed at least annually. Unless earlier reviewed, this schedule shall be placed on the Board of Directors' April agenda for each year to determine if the established fee structure adequately meets the needs of the District.
