

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 78 OF ORDINANCE NO. 4 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR WATER SERVICE BY THE SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, as follows:

Section 1. Section 78 of the Ordinance No. 4 entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing Rates, Rules, and Regulations for Water Service by the Sunnyslope County Water District", passed and adopted September 6, 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

78. Installation Charges. Where a regular charge has been fixed for the type of service connection desired, such regular charge shall be paid in advance by the applicant. Where there is no regular charge, the District reserves the right to require the applicant to deposit an amount equal to the estimated cost of such service connection. The schedule of regular service connection charges is as follows:

<u>Size of Service</u>	<u>Charge</u>
3/4-inch	\$ 100
1 -inch	125

All service connections of sizes larger than 1-inch shall be made at cost plus 10%. No service connections to properties outside the boundaries of the District shall be made without prior approval of such connection by the Board. The granting of permission for such outside connections shall be optional with the Board. Only duly authorized employees or agents of the District will be authorized to install service connections.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Re: Change in Meter Installation Charge

Gentlemen:

We note from the minutes of April 11, 1957, that the Board intends to increase the meter charge for $1\frac{1}{2}$ " meters. Since the charge was established by Ordinance No. 4 of the District, any change must be by amendment of the Ordinance.

Enclosed herewith find the original and 6 copies of a form of Ordinance No. 7 which would amend Section 78 of Ordinance No. 4. We have left the charge for a 2" meter blank inasmuch as it would seem to be inappropriate to have the same charge for a 2" connection as will now be provided for a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " connection.

We would suggest that the Board consider adjusting the 2" rate upward so that it will be in line with the new $1\frac{1}{2}$ " connection charge.

We also note that the new charge is not to go into effect until after the installation of two new connections. Since this is the case, we would suggest that the ordinance not be adopted until after the deposit has been made for these two connections. For this reason we have left the date of adoption of the ordinance blank. Upon adoption, the date should be filled in and the vote corrected, if necessary.

Upon adoption of the ordinance the seal should be affixed at the place indicated and the original and copies of the ordinance should be executed on behalf of the District. After this has been done the original and copies should be placed in the files of the District, except that two copies should be returned to this office.

Re: Revised form of Ordinance No. 7

Gentlemen:

Subsequent to the preparation of the form of Ordinance No. 7 relating to meter installation charges, we received a request from the District Secretary to consider eliminating the direct charge on 2-inch meters.

Enclosed herewith are the original and six copies of a revised form of Ordinance No. 7. The ordinance would make the meter installation rates cover services up to 1-1/2-inch. All service connections in excess of 1-1/2-inch would be computed on the basis of cost of installation plus 10 per cent.

If the revised form of the ordinance is adopted, the original form submitted with our letter of April 16, 1957, should be destroyed. Otherwise, the instructions contained in our letter of April 16, 1957, would apply.

We want to put a minimum charge of \$100.00 or cost plus 10%, whichever is the most, which will keep installations of both the 1" and 3/4" installations. In explanation, the reason for putting the \$100.00 minimum is that we have demanded that all subdividers put the lead in pipe from the main to the property line as well as putting in the mains. Consequently, we can make some profit on those installations whenever we do install them; so, please set up the ordinance as I have suggested above and I am sure the Board will be ready to adopt it at the next meeting as I have just had a discussion with President Bob Renz.
