

RESOLUTION NO. 198

A RESOLUTION REVOKING PRIOR REGULATIONS AND ESTABLISHING NEW REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS AND OTHER MATERIALS TO BE SENT TO EACH VOTER IN ADDITION TO A SAMPLE BALLOT

GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION 1977

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, that pursuant to Section 10012 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this Board does hereby revoke all prior rules, regulations and policies, and establish the following new rules, regulations and policies, which shall be applicable to the election of officers for this District at the 1977 General District Election of such officers, and all subsequent elections of such officers until said regulations are revoked or amended, to wit:

1. No candidate's Statement of Qualifications shall exceed 200 words.
2. A candidate availing himself or herself of any or all of the services set forth in said Section 10012 shall be charged and pay for the costs of printing, handling and translating pertaining to his or her Statement of Qualifications, if any.
3. A candidate shall not be charged for any costs incurred for Spanish language materials required by law, unless such costs were incurred at candidate's request.
4. Candidates shall not be permitted to prepare and submit for inclusion with the sample ballot and voter's pamphlet any materials other than a Statement of Qualifications.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the County Clerk and that the County Clerk be, and is hereby, authorized and requested to inform each candidate and prospective candidate of the foregoing.
